Appreciative Post Mortem MUHC (McGill University Health Center) project

Execution of the massive MUHC project involved more than 300 specialists, as well as a workforce of more than 10,000. The Glen complex alone spreads over an area of 250,550 m² and includes 12,500 rooms. The project was especially challenging and complex, due partly to an accelerated design-build construction method.
